Chanukah History



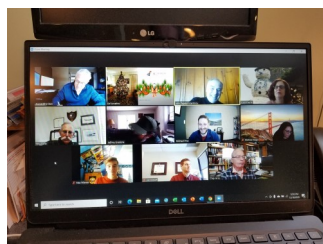

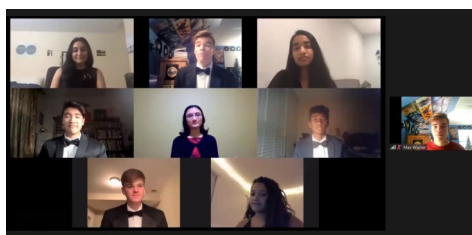

We wish you all a very happy and safe holiday season and we are grateful for all your support throughout 2020. We look forward to a better 2021.



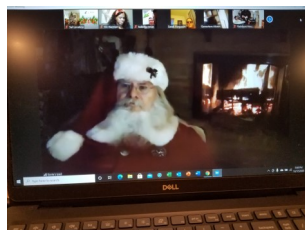


LifeTies

Executive Director, Lori Morris, is pictured with our member Eric Rosenblum upon presentation of a check from Rotary in support of this great organization..

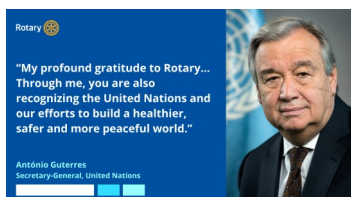
